Instruction to Bidders(ITB) regarding this bid

Selection Method:

The selection method is Least Cost Based Selection (LCBS or L1). The order would be placed for execution of an event as per scope of work at the cost/negotiated lump sum cost towards execution of an event.

- 1) Technical Evaluation Criteria The Procurement entity will carry out a detailed evaluation of the bids as per Technical Qualification Criteria mentioned in this RFP on the basis of technical presentation by the empaneled bidders.
- a. All the empaneled bidders who have submitted their bid shall have to make a presentation to demonstrate their understanding of the concept and present their solution/ approach/ methodology/ plan and capability for execution & managing the entire event in an aesthetic fashion.
 - i. The bidder shall provide the details of event execution/management approach & methodology and execution strategy proposed for carrying out the said assignment.
 - ii. As a part of Technical qualification process, the bidders shall be required to make a detailed presentation. The presentation shall consist the aspects covering as per below table:

- b. Scoring shall be done by the technical evaluation committee on the technical presentation for the above mentioned points.
- c. Marking for a given criterion may be given based upon demonstration of the same in the presentation.
- d. Only bidder who score at-least 70 percent marks shall be termed as technically qualified and would be eligible for opening of financial bids.

2. Tabulation of Technical Bids

- a) Technical Bids (Concept & presentation) have been invited, they shall be tabulated by the bid evaluation committee in the form of a comparative statement to evaluate the qualification of the bidders.
- b) The members of bid evaluation committee shall give their recommendations below the table as to which of the bidders have been found to be qualified in evaluation of Technical Bids and sign it.
- c) The number of firms qualified in technical evaluation, if less than three and it is considered necessary by the procuring entity to continue with the procurement process, reasons shall be recorded in writing and included in the record of the procurement proceedings.
- d) The bidders who are qualified in the technical evaluation shall be informed in writing.

3. Evaluation & Tabulation of Financial Bids

Subject to the provisions of "Acceptance of Successful Bid and Award of Contract" below, the procuring entity shall take following actions for evaluation of financial Bids: -

- a) The financial Bids of the technically qualified bidders, shall be opened online at notified time, by the bid evaluation committee in the presence of the bidders or their representatives who choose to be present.
- b) The names of the bidders, the rates given by them and conditions put, if any, shall be read out and recorded;
- c) Conditional Bids are liable to be rejected;
- d) The evaluation shall include all costs and all taxes and duties applicable to the bidder as per law of the Central/ State Government/ Local Authorities, and the evaluation criteria specified in the bidding documents shall only be applied;
- e) L1 will be successful bidder.

4. Award of Work Order

Successful Bidder will be assigned the work and it is expected that after issuance of work order, the successful bidder would sign an agreement with in three days with Department of Tourism, Govt. of Rajasthan and commence the preparations with immediate effect.

All other terms & conditions will remain as per provision of GF&AF and RTPP Act & Rules.
